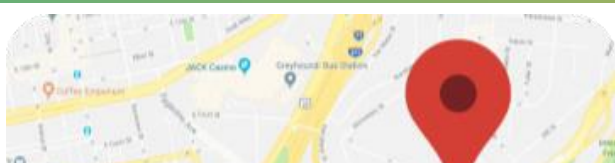
We look forward to forming an amicable and meaningful partnership with the current administration, knowing that collaboration will help our community to thrive.

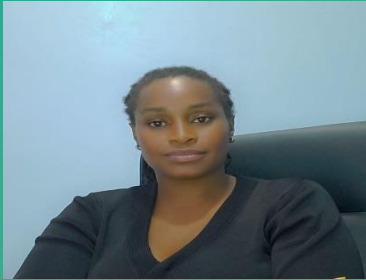

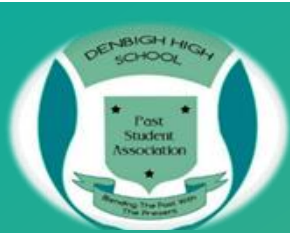

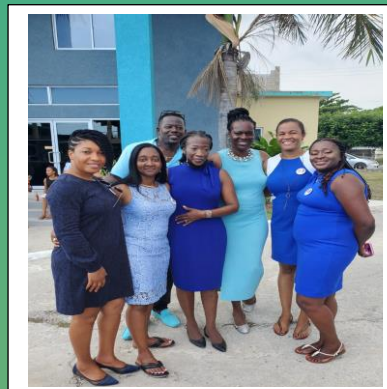
